
If the debtor does not stay defaulter, the last installment is paid by State government







Ports

6 ports, strategically located, making the State an important logistics center in the country

Santa Catarina has 3 of the 5 largest ports of imports and exports in Brazil.

Best Environmental Development Indexes (IDA) in Brazil:

1st place - Port of Itajaí

4th place - Port of São Francisco do Sul

Infrastructure & LOGISTICS

- **Modern infrastructure** of ports and roads. It facilitates and reduces the cost of transporting goods and cargo.
- 3 out of the 10 largest ports in Brazil.
- 2nd state in terms of maritime handling volume cargo
- Wide access to the **South American market**, by land.
- The State imports industrial and agroindustrial supplies. Companies that settle in Santa Catarina may have reduced rates and special incentives for the importation of these supplies

Highways

With an area of over 95 thousand squared Km, Santa Catarina's roadways are divided into approximately 2,600 km of Federal Highways and 6,000 km of State Highways, in addition to Municipal Highways.

R\$ 1.5 billion of investments in road network in 2023, including recovery of highways and works. Goal: to improve production flow and transport across regions.






Railways

Much of the Brazilian rail network is concentrated in the South and Southeast regions.

Airports

Health

100% covered: the Health for Schools Program (PSE) reached all **295 municipalities** in the State in 2023.

Santa Catarina leads the National Organ Donor Ranking and broke **records in transplants**





Education

Democratization of educational technologies and the improvement of school infrastructure are among the Government's investment priorities

Santa Catarina education is constantly honored with awards for good practices in Public Management.

Valuing educators: the category professionals with higher education and 40-hour workload are guaranteed a minimum monthly remuneration of **R\$ 5 thousand.**

These and other measures generate an impact greater than **R\$1 billion** in the annual budget.



Security

Technology in public security: widespread use of cameras, drones, robots, apps, software and system integration.

Safer environment: drop in crime rates.

The State is always looking for strategic partnerships to automate, expand and update its security.

It devepols agent exchange programs, who receive training and qualification in other countries, as well as the establishment of various technical cooperation agreements in public security.

Snow is frequent on the Santa Catarina plateau, in cities like São Joaquim, Urubici and Urupema, from June to August





The Regional Bank for the Development of the Extreme South is a public financial institution of development - which has financial and administrative autonomy - controlled by the three southern States of Brazil: Santa Catarina, Rio Grande do Sul and Paraná.

It supports and monitors projects of all sizes, aiming to increase the competitiveness of these companies.

BADESC

The Development Agency of the State of Santa Catarina aims to promote the economic and social development of the State of Santa Catarina, through medium and long term financing.

These operations are carried out using own resources and institutional funds, as well as national and international financial agencies.



It is the main instrument of the Federal Government for long-term financing and investment in all segments of the Brazilian economy. It supports entrepreneurs of all scales in carrying out its modernization, expansion and new business plans.

As a public company and not a commercial bank, **The National Bank for Economic and Social Development** evaluates the granting of support with a focus on socioenvironmental and economic impact. It has more than 100 lines of credit to support investors.






S&P Global Ratings
